

# Instructions for Claiming Pharmacy CE Credit: **Emergency Medicine Pharmacotherapy with Resuscitation (EMPowerRx) Conference**

To be compliant with ACPE requirements and ensure reporting of credits to the CPE Monitor, please complete the process below within 30 days. Credit claimed greater than 60 days from the date of the program will be automatically rejected by the CPE Monitor per NABP policy.

**Deadline to complete evaluation and claim credit: Tuesday, May 10, 2022**

1. Visit our website: <https://cop.sc.learningexpressce.com>
2. **Log in** to our website:
  - If you have attended a program accredited by SCCP or UofSC COP and created an account in the past, please do not create a new account. Select the **“Login”** link on the right side of the page. *Your username is your email address. If you cannot remember your password, click “Forgot Password?” (you will receive an email; please check your spam filter if you do not receive), email us at CE@cop.sc.edu, or call our office at 803-777-9979.*
  - If you have never attended a program accredited by SCCP or UofSC COP, click **“Create an Account”** on the right side of the page. Once you have created your account, you will be logged in. *Please note that just because you registered for the program prior to attending does not mean you have an account on our website: the two processes are separate!*
3. Click on the **“Complete Test/Evaluation”** tab on the left side of the page.
4. The **“Programs and Pending CE”** page will display. At the bottom of the page is a gray bar which states **“To access a private program, enter the registration code here”**. *Note: You only need to complete this step once. After you have registered for the meeting, it will appear under your “Pending/Private Programs” list for you to return and complete all evaluations.*
  - If you are a pharmacist, please enter the code: **EMPR322 (this is the code for both days)**
5. Your program details will display. Check the boxes next to the sessions you attended (in their entirety) and click on the green **“Register Now”** button at the bottom.
6. **Confirm your personal information** – especially your NABP E-ID and month/day of birth. Complete all of the evaluation questions regarding the program as a whole. Click on the blue **“Register”** button at the bottom.
7. Scroll to the bottom of the page. Click on the green **“Complete Evaluation”** button next to the first session you attended, **enter the evaluation access code provided at the end of the session**, answer all of the questions, and click **“Submit”**. **Complete this process for each session attended.** *This credit will automatically be reported to the CPE Monitor if you have completed this process within 60 days of the event and have provided the correct e-Profile ID and month/day of birth. Individual credit statements or transcripts may be printed from your NABP e-Profile.*
